5 (a) STATE OPTION.—

6 (1) IN GENERAL.—Section 1903(v)(4)(A) of the
7 Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396b(v)(4)(A)) is
8 amended—

9 (A) in the matter preceding clause (i)—

10 (i) by striking “children and pregnant
11 women” and inserting “individuals”; and

12 (ii) by striking “either or both” and
13 inserting “any or all”; and

14 (B) by adding at the end the following:

15 “(iii) OTHER LAWFULLY RESIDING IN-
16 DIVIDUALS.—Individuals who are not de-
17 scribed in clause (i) or (ii).”.

18 (2) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made
19 by paragraph (1) take effect on January 1, 2014.

20 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Effective as if en-
21 acted on October 1, 2009, subparagraph (H) of section
22 2107(e)(1) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
23 1397gg(e)(1)) is amended by striking “Paragraph (4) of
24 section 1903(v)” and inserting “Clauses (i) and (ii) of sec-
25 tion 1903(v)(4)”.
