Survey Overview

- Statewide survey of Latino registered voters in state of Arizona
- Primary aim was to understand Latino views towards Arizona immigration law, SB 1070
- n=402, margin of error +/- 4.9
- Field dates, April 30 May 5, 2010 (law was signed April 23)
- Partnered with Latino politics faculty at Arizona State University, and Northern Arizona University

What do you think are the most important issues that President Obama and the Congress should address over the next year?




Latino views on SB 1070








Views by generation status








Views by party identification












Profiling views by generation








