
Finding that They are not Prepared When They Get

Common Core State Standards & Assessments











The Common Core

- Consistent, academic guidelines in math and English
- [State] adopted them in 20[XX]
- More than 40 states have adopted them
- Applies to public, charter and magnet schools





The Common Core: Why Have Them?

- All students held to same high standards
- Students who meet the standards will not need remedial course work after high school graduation.
- Right now = 1/3 need it in college
- Compare student progress across states
- Better assessments to measure what students know





New Tests

Apply knowledge and skills:

- Communications
- Teamwork
- Critical thinking
- Analytical writing
- Problem solving


Standards & Assessments are Not Enough


- Challenging curriculum and effective instruction



What is the Common Core?

The Common Core State Standards establish clear and consistent guidelines for what students should know and be able to do at each grade level in English and math. These state-led standards ensure that all students are prepared for success after graduation regardless of their background.
