Our nation's social and economic success depends on the stability, vibrancy and health of every person. **That's why the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) is so important.**



SNAP helps fight child poverty:



In 2017, the program helped lift more than **3 million adults** and **1.5 million children** out of poverty.

SNAP makes economic sense.



Every **\$1.00** spent on SNAP yields **\$1.80** of economic activity.

Latinos and SNAP

The SNAP benefits received by Latinos contributes to **\$67.2 billion** in related economic activity. This economic benefit could be higher since nearly 4 million eligible Latinos do not participate in the program.



In 2017, UnidosUS's **Comprando Rico y Sano** program helped enroll **25,636** eligible Latinos into SNAP.
