Medicaid and CHIP Enrollment

If people are out of work, have lost their health insurance, had major life changes, or need some temporary help to afford health coverage, they may qualify for Medicaid.

Medicaid is a low-cost or free health insurance option that can help people get the care they and their families need and avoid large medical bills. It covers doctor visits, hospital care, prescriptions, mental health care, and more. Eligibility for Medicaid is based on income and family size. Anyone can apply for Medicaid at any time of the year.

Ending of Public Health Emergency (PHE) / Medicaid Unwinding

A [recent federal report](#) found that 4.6 million Latinos* and 5.5 million children are likely to lose Medicaid when the COVID-19 public health emergency ends, if pre-pandemic policies and practices do not change. These Medicaid losses will be by far the largest in American history.

Once the PHE ends, states will begin reviewing individual Medicaid and CHIP eligibility again. Millions of people are at risk of losing their coverage, including those who may still be eligible for Medicaid/CHIP. This often happens when the state mails a notice to the family asking for more information, and the family does not respond quickly and completely. This can happen because:

- The family moved, and the state agency sends the notice to the wrong address.
- The state never had the right address in the first place.
- The family does not open the letter in time.
- The notice is confusing or in a language the family does not understand.
- The notice is not clear about the steps the family needs to take.
- The family cannot reach their state agency with questions.
- The family does not fill out the form and submit it by the due date.

Nearly two-thirds of the Latinos losing coverage, and almost three-fourths of the children will remain eligible for the program but be terminated because of red tape and missing paperwork. It covers doctor visits, hospital care, prescription medications, mental health care, and more.</p> <p>⚠ Remember: Applying for Medicaid or CHIP will not have immigration consequences for you or anyone in your family. If you are concerned about this, check with your immigration lawyer.</p>

<p>Don't lose your MEDICAID COVERAGE due to outdated information!</p> <p>If you have Medicaid health insurance:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">  ✓ Make sure your address and contact information are on file.  ✓ If you've moved within the last 3 years, verify your address is updated on your Medicaid file.  ✓ Make sure Medicaid knows how to contact you in case of changes to your coverage. <p>Visit your state's Medicaid website and make sure your information is up to date!</p> <p>UNIDOSUS</p>	<p>One of the reasons people who have Medicaid may lose their coverage is because they don't have an updated address on their Medicaid file, and their local agency can't locate them.</p> <p>Verify your Medicaid information to make sure all your information is up to date!</p> <p>Find contact information for your state's program: Medicaid.gov/Renewals.</p>

ADDITIONAL MESSAGING

Medicaid and CHIP: English

- Enrollment in Medicaid and CHIP is open year-round.
- Eligibility varies by state. Most states cover low-income adults under age 65. In all states, Medicaid and CHIP cover low-income individuals who are:
 - Children aged 18 or younger
 - Pregnant women
 - People with disabilities
 - Over age 65
- Eligibility for Medicaid and CHIP is largely based on income, age, citizenship or immigration status, and eligible dependents.

- States will soon begin the process of redetermining eligibility for everyone currently enrolled in Medicaid. Make sure they have your most recent contact information!
 - This process is nationwide and is unrelated to your or a family member's immigration status – it's important to respond right away when the state contacts you about your Medicaid coverage.

Medicaid and CHIP: Spanish

- La inscripción a Medicaid y CHIP está abierta todo el año.
- La elegibilidad varía según el estado. La mayoría de los estados cubren a adultos de bajos ingresos menores de 65 años. En todos los estados, Medicaid y CHIP cubren a las personas de bajos ingresos que son:
 - Niños de 18 años o menos
 - Mujeres embarazadas
 - Personas con discapacidad
 - Mayores de 65 años
- La elegibilidad para Medicaid y CHIP se basa en gran medida en los ingresos, la edad, la ciudadanía o el estatus migratorio y dependientes elegibles.

- Los estados pronto comenzarán el proceso de volver a determinar la elegibilidad de todas las personas actualmente inscritas en Medicaid. ¡Asegúrate de que tengas tu información de contacto más reciente!
 - Este proceso es nacional y no está relacionado con su estado migratorio o el de un miembro de su familia; es importante responder de inmediato cuando el estado se comunique con usted acerca de su cobertura de Medicaid.
